**Fine Arts' exhibits may only be accepted by the superintendent for the department during the time specified. No early or late entries will be accepted by any other fair board member or volunteer.**

**Please read all instructions carefully.**

### GENERAL RULES

1. Entries open to any resident of Minnesota. All entries must be the original work of the exhibitor and not previously shown at the Olmsted County Fair. All work must have been completed within the past 2 years. **No Kits**
2. An exhibitor may have ONLY ONE entry per lot.
3. RESTRICTIONS:
  - a. No Paint By Number
  - b. All paintings must be dry
  - c. Size must not exceed 24" x 36" (excluding frame)  
Size requirement does not include non- hanging art
4. Sculptures is any 3 – dimensional object any media
5. Definition of PROFESSIONAL (Class 130) is a person who earns a living in the art field (i.e. commercial artist, graphic designer, teacher) or shows in an Art Gallery.
6. Definition of HOBBY (Class 120) is one who pursues art as a hobby, yet occasionally sell without solicitation
7. At time of entry, ALL art work must have identification on back – Name, Address, Telephone Number.
8. **All hanging art MUST BE FRAMED and have a picture wire or secure loop for hanging. NO saw tooth hangers allowed. Wrapped canvases need not be framed, they must have hangers.**
9. Mediums that smug must have protective coverings. The County Fair or its volunteers ARE NOT held liable for damages.
10. Judges will determine 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> place, and Best of Show, Honorable Mention ribbons will be awarded at the judges' discretion
11. **All artwork will remain on exhibit until the conclusion of the show and can only be picked up Sunday night, July 28, between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm**
